Dear Mr. Augustine:

The City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma is submitting an application to the Federal Highway Administration for a \$5 million BUILD1 (Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development) grant to complete the County Line Multi-Modal Corridor Overpass. After consultation with Transportation Department officials we are submitting an updated application for a project previously requesting TIGER Grant funds; updated to reflect recent changes. New letters of support are included in this submittal.

The project consists of an iconic four-lane bridge on County Line Road over the Broken Arrow Expressway, and widening the Expressway under the bridge to three lanes in both directions. The bridge includes an ADA-compliant concrete sidewalk on the west side and a ten-foot-wide multipurpose trail on the east side.
