# **2018 Broken Arrow General Obligation Bond Public Meetings**

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

# Overview

After the 2017 Citizen Survey, Broken Arrow city leaders held three public meetings in various locations in order to gain input on proposed projects for the 2018 General Obligation (GO) Bond package.

The three meetings were as follows:

# Thursday, February 22

• South Broken Arrow Baptist Church

• Estimated attendance: 100

# Monday, February 26

• Battle Creek Clubhouse

Estimated attendance: 85

# Tuesday, February 27

Forest Ridge Golf Club

Estimated attendance: 100

Each meeting began with an overview / presentation of the projects. The room was divided into the following stations:

- Streets Arterials
- Streets Neighborhoods
- Streets Specialty
- Stormwater
- Public Safety
- Special Projects
- Parks & Quality of Life

Each station had a representative to answer questions about the proposed projects and a scribe to write down citizen's feedback. Over the three meetings, more than 350 comments were transcribed – which are all listed in this report.

# **Synopsis of Station Comments**

### Streets - Arterials

-Widespread support for streets surrounding Indian Springs Sports Complex. Several general support comments for overall street projects and improvements

### Streets - Neighborhoods

- High number of requests for general road and curb fixes & more sidewalks

### Streets – Specialty
