
Street Closure


As part of the 2nd phase of the County Line Trunk Sewer project, Belt Construction, Inc. will be starting construction on the installation of a 48" new sewer trunk line along the West side of County Line Rd / 193rd St. As part of this work, the contractor will need to stage in the south bound lanes of the roadway to safely work around the existing compromised County Line Trunk sewer pipe. To accomplish this, the southbound two lanes will be consolidated into a single lane and placed in the middle turn lane for the extent of the work zone. The work zone is from 1,000 feet north of 111th Street extended down to the west bound on-ramp to the Creek Turnpike. The traffic control will be phased such that is only placed where the contractor is currently working. All turning side streets and driveways access shall be maintained during construction. This traffic control will be in place as early as next week and will be in use for 3 to 4 months, weather dependent.








Hospital, City close deal 14 acre land sale in south BA

- SoundMind Behavior Health agrees to purchase 14-acres of City Authority-owned land in south BA.
- The land will be used to build a 55,000 square foot hospital, whose primary purpose will be to treat mental health issues caused by dementia and Alzheimer's.

Background:

Today, SoundMind Behavior Health is pleased to announce the purchase of land located at the northwest corner of Aspen (145th East) Avenue and the Creek Turnpike in Broken Arrow.

In 2019, the City of Broken Arrow's Economic Development Authority entered into an economic development agreement to sell 14 acres of Authority-owned land to SoundMind for \$300,000 to build a specialty hospital designed to help address the growing medical needs of the senior population. The hospital's primary purpose will be to treat mental health disorders and behaviors caused by dementia and Alzheimer's related problems.

SoundMind will begin construction in spring 2020 on a 55,000 square foot behavior health hospital serving communities throughout Northeast Oklahoma. The hospital is being designed by Dewberry Architects in Tulsa and will be constructed by Cowen Construction. The Hospital is expected to open by the fall of 2021.

SoundMind Behavior Health would like to thank everyone at the City of Broken Arrow for making this much-needed hospital a reality.

"The Mayor, the Economic Development Team and the City Manager are to be thanked. No one at the City of Broken Arrow ever gave up on the project and worked hard to make it a reality," said Dr. Selam Negusse, co-owner of SoundMind Behavior Health.

"There is not another city in the country working harder to improve their community than the City of Broken Arrow," said Steve Easley, Development Consultant for SoundMind.

SoundMind's mission is to provide inpatient and outpatient mental health services for patients 55 years of age and older suffering from acute mental and behavioral symptoms

"SoundMind Behavioral Hospital is just another example of the City of Broken Arrow's dedication to improving the quality of life for our community," said Norm Stephens, Economic Development Manager for the City of Broken Arrow. "The Behavioral Hospital will create good paying jobs, provide greater density and daytime traffic in south Broken Arrow. Additionally, the Hospital will prove to be a catalyst for additional restaurants, retail and office space in the southwest portion of Broken Arrow."




