"Patriots in the Park promises to be a wonderful, signature event for Broken Arrow that is sure to be exciting for the entire family," said Mayor Craig Thurmond. "This will be a tremendous extravaganza in Broken Arrow, for Broken Arrow and by Broken Arrow."

The Mayor also acknowledged the almost 20 year Broken Arrow tradition that was Rockets Over Rhema.
