The type of tree/shrub selected will be from a list of Oklahoma hardy species that include Lacebark Elm, Redbud, Crepe Myrtle, Oregon or Bosnian Pine, Chinese Pistache, Shumard Oak, Water Oak, Bald Cypress, American Holly, Trident Maple, and Shatung Maple.

Trees ordered between January 1<sup>st</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup> will be planted in the fall and trees ordered between July 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>th</sup> will be planted in the spring.
