Living Green Procedures

"Low Impact Development"

<u>Background</u> – Living Green Low Impact Development (LID) is a voluntary program established by the City of Broken Arrow to promote a more efficient use of the land that reduces overall impact to the environment.

<u>Procedure</u> – The procedure for the Living Green LID program is as follows:

- 1. Applicant fills out an application and submits the application, plans and fees to the Development Services Department.
- 2. Development Services staff will process the application and review the plans for compliance with the Living Green LID Criteria Manual and LID areas.
- 3. The points awarded are all or none and will be determined for each area as described on the checklist/application.
- 4. Staff will assign the points and LID Level.
- 5. The applicant will be notified of the point total and LID Level Certification (Platinum, Gold, Silver or Bronze).
- 6. The application and plans will be processed, stamped and one (1) copy will be given back to the applicant.
- 7. A certificate and placard will be provided to the applicant, with the stamped plans at the time of acceptance by the City.
- 8. Information will be posted on the City website, Focus flyer and on the City's television station.
