#### **Definitions**

- **Priority 1 =** Crimes in progress involving life-threatening circumstances and situations that produce or are likely to produce serious bodily injury or death to any person.
- Priority 2 = Crimes in progress or that have just occurred, incidents in progress that present the potential for injury or property damage/loss, situations where the suspect is still at the scene or in the area and will elude apprehension or create the potential for injury or property damage if the police do not arrive rapidly, incidents where an officer is needed to secure a scene or witnesses, and incidents where there is a need for crowd control or traffic control which, if not done immediately, would create the imminent potential for injury or property damage/loss.
- Priority 3 = Crimes against people that are misdemeanors in progress or that have just occurred, reports of recent felony crimes, suspicious circumstances with no threat of injury, and incidents that do not require an officer immediately, but need investigation, mediation, or intervention.
- **Priority 4 =** Property or service related calls for an officer to respond that cannot be handled by telephone, misdemeanor reports when caller demands officer or when an officer needs to investigate the scene or




# **Broken Arrow Police Department** August 2020 Calls For Service



Priority 5 = Primarily officer-initiated calls or ten-codes used for in-house purposes.

Priority 6 = Calls for Animal Control Officer response.

Priority 7 = Calls for Standby Public Works services, i.e., water, sewer, streets, electrician, etc.

# Tactical change coming to Broken Arrow's New Orleans Square Revitalization effort underway in south BA / Overnight detour Sept. 3

New Orleans Square, the intersection at Elm Place and New Orleans Ave., is getting a facelift overnight.

The intersection, also known as S. 161st E. Ave. and E. 101st St. S., will be closed for 12 hours from Thursday, Sept. 3 at 8 p.m., until Friday, Sept. 4 at 8 a.m., for the first installation of the City's Tactical Urbanism plan.

"We will be painting the crosswalks with vibrant colors at the intersection, installing an art photo opportunity, benches, landscaping, and new signage to show off the New Orleans Square name," said Broken Arrow Director of Community Development Larry Curtis.

The Broken Arrow City Council voted to rename the area New Orleans Square after seeking naming recommendations from the community. According to Curtis, the new signage will serve to let people know this is an area that is developing.


"This is the first installation, and we hope to have additional installations every quarter," Curtis said.

The intersection work will be complete within 12 hours, weather permitting, while the remainder of the project is to be complete before Saturday.

This Tactical Urbanism project is a part of the plan presented to the City Council Sept. 1 by the Small Area Committee for Elm and New Orleans. The committee has been working together for a year to find innovative ways to stimulate interest in the 100-acre area.

"Hopefully, the whole area will be rejuvenated in the coming year or two and beyond that," City of Broken Arrow Placemaking Manager Farhad Daroga said. "There are many other wonderful projects yet to come."
