Battle Creek Golf Club – September Review

General

The month of September continued the busy trend with more rounds & revenues compared to prior year. Total revenues for the month were \$187,412 which was \$11,185 more than budgeted revenues and also \$17,412 more than last September's total revenues. Battle Creek had 4,220 total rounds for September which were 729 more rounds than last year and 345 more than budgeted rounds. Battle Creek GC is still offering optional single cart rider for golf cart usage to customers as well as currently on 10 minute tee time intervals to space groups out more due to increased golf cart demand. Tournament rounds are naturally dramatically lower this year due to Covid-19 concerns for group outings but public play has greatly increased this year to offset lost revenues for events.

Golf Operations

During the month of September 2020 Battle Creek Golf Club hosted a total of 5 outside events totaling 414 tournament rounds. Many of the tournaments postponed or rescheduled for next year in hopes they could host events without social distancing measures. The Annual Club Championship was held during the month and had 36 players compete in the tournament. This year's overall Club Championship was Greg Mason with scores of 68-74 for a -2 total.

Merchandise sales for the month of September were \$17,738. This year's sales were almost the exact same as last years without the tournaments but were lower than they could've been due to Covid-19 and patrons shopping from home online. Overall the month was outstanding with 4,220 rounds to a budget of 3,875. Last September the club did 3,491 over the same period.

Course Maintenance

In September there was a total of 3.45 inches of rainfall this month. The temperatures ranged from the mid 90's for highs and as low as the mid 40's for overnight lows.

The maintenance team work has been on weekly mowing of all playing areas of the course, sprayed wetting agents to tee boxes, green surrounds, and fairways to extend the time intervals between watering of these areas, Irrigation repairs as needed, sprayed greens with fungicides ,plant growth regulators, and insecticides as needed, sprayed plant growth regulators to tees, green surrounds, and fairways to limit clippings on these areas and began mowing all native areas. Next month will finish seasonal mowing schedules and mow all native areas for the final time of the season fertilize the golf course to help with green up in the spring, trim trees and brushy areas out of pond edges, ditches and native areas as well.

Broken Arrow tops out replacement Fire Station 3

The new station replaces an older station near Indian Springs

Officials from the City of Broken Arrow will hold a topping out ceremony for a replacement for Broken Arrow Fire Station 3 at 10:30 a.m., Monday, Oct. 19.

The ceremony will be held at the project site which is on the west side of 23rd Street (County Line Road/193rd East Avenue), north of the Creek Turnpike at approximately 115th Street. Do not park in or block the private drive north of the project site.

The new station replaces an older Station 3, currently located about two miles away on Elm Place north of Jasper (131st) Street.

“We use a great deal of data and research to determine the most effective location for our resources, including this and all future fire stations, in order to maintain quick response times and superior customer service to our citizens” said Fire Chief Jeremy Moore. “We are pleased to see this new home for our firefighters coming one step closer to completion.”

Once complete, the new Fire Station 3 will have three bays sized and equipped for modern firefighting apparatus. Reco Enterprises is constructing the station, which will cost about \$3.8 million. The project is funded by the voter-approved 2011 and 2014 General Obligation bonds.

A topping out is being held in place of a traditional groundbreaking because that was not possible during the initial shelter-in-place order for the COVID-19 pandemic.

The City of Broken Arrow Streets and Stormwater Department will close Washington (91st) Street between Garnett Road and Olive (129th East) Avenue at 9 p.m., Friday, Oct. 23 until 7 a.m., Saturday, Oct. 24.

The road closure is necessary in order for crews to perform a storm sewer pipe installation required for the Washington Street widening project.

Local access for neighborhoods will remain open, but through traffic must detour onto Houston (81st) to the north or New Orleans (101st) to the south.

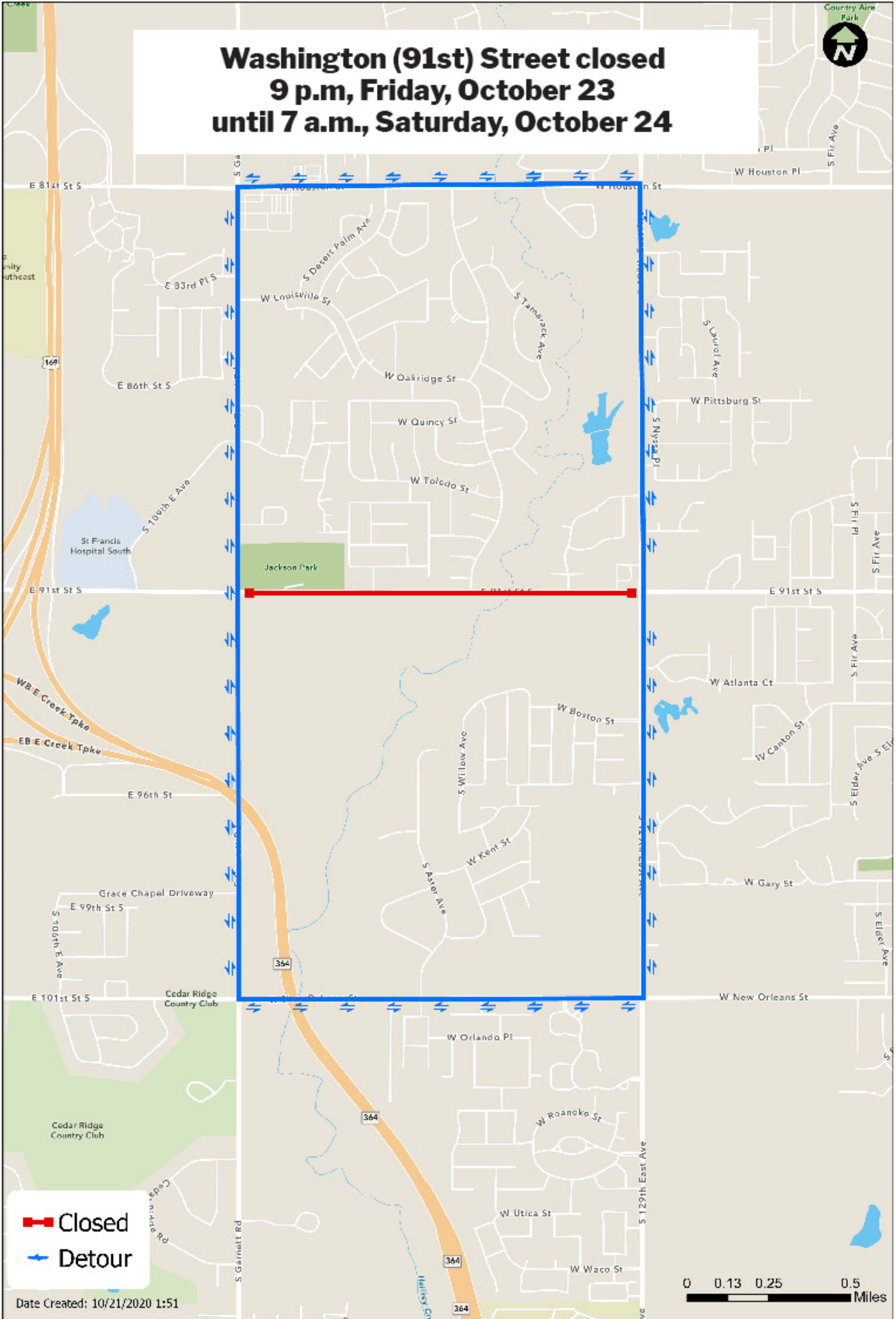
Since taking over the project in September, City crews have worked tirelessly to bring the project up to speed with completion scheduled for early 2021.
