PROPOSITION 1

TRANSPORTATION

- Widen Houston St. from Garnett Rd. to Aspen Ave.
- Widen 23rd St. (County Line) from Omaha St. to Albany St. (north of BA high school)
- Widen Elm Pl. from Kenosha St. to State Highway 51
- Reconstruct the intersection at Washington and Aspen Ave.
- Add dual left turn lanes to Kenosha St. at the intersection of 9th St.
- Improve the intersection at 9th St. and Hillside Dr.
- Repair neighborhood streets throughout BA





PROPOSITION 2 PUBLIC SAFETY

- Build Fire Station No. 7
- Purchase emergency vehicles
- Renovate existing jail facility
- Update outdoor warning sirens

PROPOSITION 3

PARKS AND RECREATION

- Develop a new park in southwest BA
- Update neighborhood playgrounds
- Construct community trail network
- Install synthetic turf on soccer fields at Indian Springs Sports Complex



PROPOSITION 4 PUBLIC FACILITIES

- Construct an annex for the Senior Citizen Center
- Construct an Armed Forces Meeting Hall for veterans
- Renovate the City's maintenance and public services buildings





PROPOSITIONS 5 & 6

STORMWATER AND DRAINAGE

- Upgrade stormwater conveyance system by Village Square II and Vandever Acres
- Improve channelization and conveyance at Indian Springs
- Improve drainage for the Adams Creek, Broken Arrow Creek, Haikey Creek and Elm or Aspen Creek Basins
