


THE WAR AT HOME MEMORIAL BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA

A JOINT PROJECT

Mission 22, in partnership with the Muscogee Nation, and the city of Broken Arrow, Oklahma, have brought 'The War at Home' memorial to it's permanent home,

This memorial remembers our brothers and sisters who lost their lives to suicide, and includes one of the only sculpture depictions of a Veteran who is also a citizen of a First Nation.

The memorial is located in Veterans Park on Main Street, and includes Gold Star and Blue Star mothers' memorials on the site. It is our hope that this work of art will inspire more people to end our war here at home.





FROM CONCEPT TO COMPLETION

Originally conceived in 2014 by Magnus Johnson, co-founder and Chief Vision Officer of Mission 22, the memorial features 20 steel plate silhouettes of Veterans who took their own lives following their return from war. Each Veteran is named at the base of each silhouette with an ID tag.

The memorial has previously been installed in Texas and Virginia, and has been seen by tens of thousands of people.

The dedication for 'The War at Home' memorial in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, will take place on May 21, 2022.
