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You must provide the following documentation:

- 1. Certification by a qualified veterinarian that the wild or exotic animal is being kept in conditions which are adequate to specific biological requirements necessary for the animal's health and well being, and in a habitat which is not cruel or abusive to the animal.
- 2. Certification by a qualified veterinarian that the animal is not a risk to the public or persons to be in close contact with the animal.
- 3. Certification by a qualified veterinarian that the animal is current on all required vaccinations and shots and that the animal does not currently have or will not have the propensity to contract any diseases or illness that could contaminate other animals or humans.
- 4. Verification of compliance with all federal and state requirements, including, but not limited to a valid USDA license if the animal is removed from the premises for any reason other than for obtaining veterinary care.
- 5. Presentation of a certified Radius Report from an abstract company or title company identifying all property owners within a 300-foot radius of the applicant's residence or business.
- 6. Payment of an annual fee
